IV. Subcommittee Reports

- A. Child Care Stefanie reported
 - 1. Last Year launched the Child Care Chirp Newsletter
 - a) asked the economic group to send out
 - b) exploring additional ways to get this out
 - (1) Working with Michigan Works to see if they could push it out through their Listserv.
 - 2. Regional Child CarePlanning Coalition (Monroe, Hillsdale, Lenawee counties)
 - a) Looking at child care perspectives from parents, businesses, and providers. A much broader lens and picture painted
 - b) Last planning meeting Hillsdale Hospital was represented on the call. Hopeful that this might promote expansion in our community
 - 3. Starting to explore Childcare Provider Recognition Month in May
 - 4. Smaller Committee. Everyone is welcome to join us!

V. RSVP Challenge Discussion

- A. Struggling with getting accurate RSVPs(Data Handout)
 - 1. We ask for RSVPs to make sure our space is big enough, we have activities to support children ages in attendance or child care needs, right fit activity materials, snacks, etc.
 - 2. People register and do not come, or do not register and come...
 - 3. Not expecting it to match perfectly, but need to try to get a bit closer
 - 4. Has anyone seen anything successful in supporting accurate RSVPs?
 - a) Require registration to participate? Turn away if not registered?

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- b) Once Registered... a day or 2 before, we would call to confirm they are still attending. This would let us know if people had something come up.
- c) Family Coalition Meeting Discussion
 - (1) They suggested a text reminder for events
 - (2) Bryce suggested a texting program
 - (a) Text and reply "C" to confirm or "P" for a phone call.
 - (b) Only costs them \$15 per month
- d) Google Phone number is free, it may have more options
- e) Remind App
 - (1) Another thing parents have to sign up for and you have to give them a code for an app
 - (2) Free, but more of a process for families
 - (3) Different codes are needed for every event
- f) Texting Base
 - (1) Buy (X) units (a certain number of texts)
 - (2) Worked nicely
 - (3) Text mas announcements
- g) Reminder Call.com (Bryce Asherg uses)
 - (1) Can read a spreadsheet
 - (2) 15.50 per month
- 5. Are going to use text on their own to start and see if it changes things for the next 3 events before we jump into the system or a new app, etc.
